



Branston Pickleball Club Membership Policy

Version 1.0

1.1 Policy Purpose

This policy outlines eligibility, application, payment, suspension, and termination of membership in accordance with Clause 6 and Clause 7 of the Constitution.

1.2 Eligibility

- Membership is open to junior and senior individuals (Clause 6.2).
- Applicants must agree to:
 - The Club Constitution.
 - All Club policies (including Code of Conduct and Welfare Policy).
 - Pickleball England regulations.

1.3 Application Process

- Applications must be submitted using the official Membership Form (see copy below).
- All forms will be reviewed by the Management Committee, who may refuse applications in line with the Equal Opportunities Policy (Clause 6.4).
- Membership is confirmed upon:
 - Approval by the Committee.
 - Payment of membership fees (Clause 6.5).
- All members must register with **Pickleball England** and provide their membership number.



1.4 Rights of Members

Upon acceptance and payment, members:

- May attend and vote at General Meetings (Clause 6.6).
- May participate in Club sessions, social events, competitions, and elections.

1.5 Suspension and Termination

- Non-payment results in **automatic suspension** (Clause 6.7).
- Non-payment after a “reasonable period” following written notice will result in termination.
- Membership may also be terminated as a result of disciplinary action.
